Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas

The Final 2016-2017 School Financial Integrity Rating System of Texas (FIRST) ratings are based on fiscal year 2016. On August 8, 2017, Texas Education Agency (TEA) affirmed its *preliminary* rating and on November 3, 2017 TEA affirmed its *final* rating. The District is pleased to announce a “**Superior**” rating for the Edgewood Independent School District based on the fifteen (15) indicators established by the Texas Education Agency.
